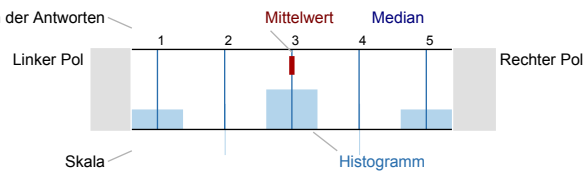

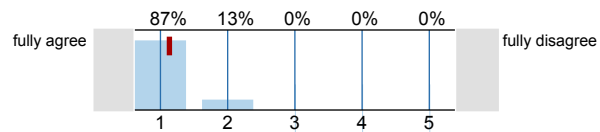
Relative Häufigkeiten der Antworten
