



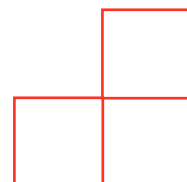

Tourism and International Relations are only available in English. Data Science and Physics offer 30 ECTS in English in Spring semester (S2).

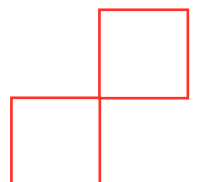


APPLICATION STEPS

NOMINATION	<p>Students cannot apply by themselves; they must be nominated by their International Office by filling in THIS FORM</p> <p>Semester 1: from March 9th to April 10th, 2026 Semester 2: from 1st to September 30th, 2026</p>
ONLINE APPLICATION	<p>Once nominated, students will receive confirmation from our International Office, together with an incoming student guide and a link to do their online application on our MoveOn platform.</p> <p>Semester 1: from May 4th to May 31st, 2026 Semester 2: from October 12th to October 31st, 2026</p>
ACCEPTATION	<p>After the application period is over, students will receive information about the process for course selection.</p> <p>WARNING: classes may experience timetable modifications in the first week of class. <u>If available</u>, we will offer alternative spots to avoid potential overlaps.</p>
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR ERASMUS STUDENTS	<p>The acceptance letter will be automatically issued once the nomination of the student has been accepted.</p> <p>The Certificate of Arrival will be automatically issued once the arrival of the student has been confirmed.</p>

COURSES SELECTION

ECTS	<p>There is a maximum number of ECTS credits that can be selected depending on the duration of stay at UE Valencia:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1 Semester: 30 ECTS 2 Semesters: 60 ECTS</p> <p>One subject usually represents 6 ECTS, meaning students can choose 5 subjects per semester. We will ask students to also choose two additional classes in case there is no place left in their first choice.</p>

Language classes	<p>UEV offers online English and Spanish classes (level A1, A2, B1 and B2). Registration for those classes are made during the first weeks of the stay via the webpage of the university.</p> <p>Face2face A1 Spanish classes (4h/week) are offered each semester and award 6 ECTS.</p>
Classes in English	<p>UEV offers 6 degrees taught in English:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Business</p> <p style="text-align: center;">International Relations</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Dentistry</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Translation</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Tourism management</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Psychology</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Marketing</p> <p>Due to the high demand in these programs, we cannot guarantee seats in these English classes and students may have no other option than following the Spanish equivalent. That is why a B2-level in Spanish is highly recommended.</p>

TRAVEL ACCOMODATION

Visa Requirements	<p>Compulsory for non-EU students, please check your student's visa requirements at the Spanish Embassy or Consulate in your home Country.</p>
Health Insurance	<p>Students are responsible for obtaining International health insurance valid throughout their stay in Spain/Europe. They must provide the International Office with a copy of their insurance on their application form. We do recommend an insurance company in our guide for incoming students.</p>
Accommodation	<p>UEV does not have any housing service. Accommodation is the responsibility of the student who can find useful tips (websites, recommendation...) in the guide for incoming students.</p>
