1st semester and full year students

4 to 15 May

Once the nomination period ends, the nomination will be confirmed and the office will contact the student, in due course, with all relevant information and instructions on how to apply online and the documentation to be uploaded prior to arrival.

The students will need to submit the following:

- Copy of **passport or national identity card**.
- Copy of **European Health Insurance Card** (only for EU citizens) and/or **private insurance** (all students). See information below.
- Students with Special Needs, certificate or medical report with the diagnosis.

Student insurance policy

The student must take out a private insurance policy which, in addition to covering medical expenses in case of accident and illness, must offer the following minimum coverage:

- Where relevant, **travel insurance** (including damage to or loss of luggage)
- **Liability insurance**
- **Accident and critical illness insurance** (including temporary or permanent incapacity)
- **Death insurance** (including repatriation)

The University of Deusto, through its Insurance Department, offers its exchange students the possibility of taking out insurance that meets these conditions, except for travel insurance. Academic requirements

Full-time students must generally register for 30 ECTS credits.

Language requirements

Undergraduate students

No official certificate is required. The student must have a sufficient level to follow courses and take exams in Spanish and/or English.

B2 is strongly recommended, and for some Modern Languages degree courses, B2 or C1 in English and/or Spanish.

If the student is not prepared to follow courses in Spanish, please check the academic offer in English to confirm that the student has enough subjects to take in order to avoid possible problems once at the University of Deusto.

Master and PhD students

Each Master's and PhD programme may have a different language requirement, but normally a C1 in the language in which the programme is taught is required. In any case, acceptance is made on an individual basis by the programme director. Additional documentation may be required to decide on acceptance.

Intensive Spanish course:	end of August

Exams:	17 to 19 December and 7 to 18 January
Resit exams:	29 January to 7 February

Second semester (Spring)

Intensive Spanish course:	end of January
Orientation:	31 January to 3 February
Classes:	4 February to 22 May
Exams:	25 May to 9 June
Resit exams:	17 to 26 June
