Nomination and application	Nomination periods for partners: - Autumn semester: Early March to 15 April - Spring Semester: Early September to 1 October Online nomination form Application deadlines for students: - Autumn semester: 1 May - Spring semester: 15 October - Nominated students will receive a link to the online application form.	
Language requirements	A minimum of level B2 (CEFR level) of English proficiency is expected. The nomination of a student is sufficient confirmation of language level. No English test is required for the application to NHH.	
Semester dates	The academic year starts in August and is divided into two semesters: - Autumn semester 2026: 7 August to 18 December - Spring semester 2027: 6 January to 18 June Registration deadlines: 1 September (autumn) / 1 February (spring)	
Courses	- ECTS scale: A to F or pass/fail. - Full semester workload: 30 ECTS credits - One course is normally 7,5 ECTS credits (45 lecture hours) - Language of instruction: English (and Norwegian) - Free Norwegian language courses 7,5 ECTS credits	
Housing	First time exchange students have the benefit of guaranteed student housing when attending NHH for one or two semesters. Student housing is offered by the Student Welfare Organisation (Sammen).
