Nomination process

STEP 1: Performed by the Home University

Mobility Coordinator from home university must nominate their students using the *International Exchange Student Nomination Form*.

STEP 2: Performed by the student

The students will receive an email with instructions. They must fill out an *admission form* and send the following documents:

- Presentation letter from home university
- Transcript of records with GPA
- Passport photocopy (ID page)
- 1 photo (3x4 cm)
- Résumé/CV (in English or Spanish)
- Medical certificate of good health
- B1 Spanish level certificate, issued by the Language Department of the home university or any other Language Center
- Motivation letter, maximum of two pages (in English or in Spanish)

Additional documentation for graduate mobility

- One academic reference letter



After receiving the admission letter, the student must send the following documents:

- Visa
- International health insurance
- Airplane tickets

NOTE: Students interested in extending their mobility program must send authorization from their home university and the renewal of their visa, foreigner ID, and international health insurance.
