



### School of Economics and Management How to arrive to ...

Braga is famous for its historical buildings, monuments, gardens and fountains. It is a beautiful city in the heart of the green Minho region where religious devotion in the form of many churches and other symbols of faith lies juxtaposed with the typical bustle of a modern city with restaurants, bars and a renowned nightlife, owing in some part to the University of Minho.

Due to its excellent geographical location, Braga is easily accessible by car, train, taxi or bus.

The city is the crossroads of 5 Highways: North (A3), South (A3 and A1 - Porto - Lisbon - Porto), East (A11 and A7) and West (A28).

The rail transport system connects Braga to various parts of the country through the CP Services (Alfa Pendular. Intercidades and Porto Urban Trains).

Regarding the road transport facilities, the Braga Central Bus Station welcomes several companies that ensure the connection amongst several regional, national and international destinations.

The Francisco Sá Carneiro Airport is the main hub in the Northwest Region of the Iberian Peninsula where do land the most relevant airlines and lowcost flights (30 minutes from Braga by highway, far out 50 km). The airport is easily accessible via the A3, via the Porto Underground and CP trains, or via the shuttle service provided by GetBus.

The Vigo Airport is headquartered about 100 km away, and it provides for bus trips directly connecting these two cities daily.

At the level of Braga Public Transport System, the whole municipality hubs the Urban Transport of Braga (TUB).
