Requirements	• A minimum GPA of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale), or average score of 80 (out of 100) or 56 (out of 70).		
	Chinese passport holders are not accepted.		
	• We have two programs in EnglishBBA (Bachelor of Business Administration) and IMBA		
	(international MBA). Each offers around 15 courses in English each semester.		
Course	 Incoming exchange students can take no more than 5 courses each semester. 		
Offering	We don't offer Chinese language course.		
	• Our courses are 2 or 3 credits each (2 or 3 weekly class hours respectively). Normally, courses		
Credit	lasts 17 weeks, and exams are scheduled for the 18 th or 19 th week.		
Transfer	In general, 1 Renmin credit is considered equivalent to 2 ECTS credits, subject to the home		
	university's calculation.		
Special	Buddy program: one-on-one assistance throughout the semester.		
Services	Student activities: campus tour, Christmas party, travels to scenic spots.
