Tradition: University of Würzburg

- First foundation in 1402 by Prince Bishop "Johann von Egloffstein"
- Second foundation in 1582 by Prince Bishop "Julius Echter von Mespelbrunn"
- In 1968 the Economic and Social Sciences separated from the Law and Political Science and constituted as an independent faculty.








Facts and Figures: the Faculty



Framework for your Exchange Semester(s)

- Attend as many courses as you wish in the orientation period (first 2 weeks).
- Decide then about the final courses you wish to take.
- Study across the disciplines + take language courses.
- ERASMUS paperwork:
 - ✓ Get your Learning Agreement signed AFTER you have finally decided which courses you attend (Agata Stopińska)
 - ✓ Get your certificate of attendance signed directly after your arrival and before you leave (Nicole Schmitt, IO)





Types of classes

Type of Course	Description
1. Lecture (Vorlesung)+ Exercise/Tutorial (Übung/Tutorium)	Both classes are part of one written exam given at the end of the semester
2. Seminar (writing a scientific paper, essay)	You have to write a scientific paper and sometimes - to show your results in an oral presentation
3. Special Seminars	You HAVE TO attend them regularly, e.g. Cross-Cultural Management
4. Online Courses https://kurse.vhb.org/VHBPORTAL/kursprogramm/kursprogramm.jsp	Programme and requirements differ, most often they consist of online classes and selfstudy of online reading scripts

- Deadline: mid-December 2025 you will receive an email with details (check your JMU account!)

Make sure to REGISTER ON TIME (no late registration for exams will be accepted)







Transcript of Records (ToR)

- As soon as the examinations have been corrected and your marks are recorded, you can generate your ToR which lists classes you took and marks you achieved. (WueStudy).
- Recording your marks might take 4-6 weeks
 after the end of the exam period.
- Should you need a general transcript of records listing all marks and courses earned in other faculties/Center for Languages, email all your individual ToRs to our IO and ask for a general ToR encompassing all marks: transcripts@uni-wuerzburg.de
